- *3. Anottappa* Fearlessness of wrong doing
- 4. *Uddhacca* Restlessness / agitation

(1) Four factors occur in **all** twelve unwholesome consciousness. (12) (-77)

They are called universal unwholesome factors (*Akusala-sādhāraņa*)

- These four factors occur in all twelve unwholesome *cittas*, for every unwholesome *citta* involves
- -a mental blindness to the danger in evil (i.e. delusion), -
- -a lack of shame and moral dread, and
- -an <u>underlying current of agitation</u> (i.e. restlessness). {p.95}
